Room and Key Worker Changes

We are making some changes for our children as they grow. We aim to make any changes as seamless as possible so some staff are moving to.

Angela is moving into Willow Room. Angela again is another experienced member of staff who will be supporting our two year olds.

Key workers will speak to you about any changes to your child's routine.

Forest School will take a short break in January while we settle children into their new spaces and welcome new children into our school. Key workers will let you know when these sessions will start again.

After spending some time in the rooms in the evenings I feel the collection arrangements need reviewing to support our children. When the doorbell rings and parents/carers come into the room it can be quite upsetting for the children who are ready to go home or disruptive to the learning taking place. So from January 2024 after 3.45pm please could you ring the doorbell for either Willow Room or Acorn Room and a member of staff will bring your child to the door. Any messages will be passed to you but hopefully this will be a more calming environment for the children still in nursery school.
